Sub: Sanction of works for provision of Video Surveillance Systems at balance 1000 A1, A, B & C category stations over Indian Railways chargeable to - Nirbhaya Fund under List of Approved works (less than ₹2.5 cr).


Sanction of Ministry of Railways is here by communicated for various Video surveillance works costing up to ₹2.5 crore each, chargeable to Plan Head 6400 Nirbhaya Fund for inclusion in the LAW Book 2016-17. Under this, Video Surveillance System are to be provided at balance 1000 A1, A, B & C category stations over Indian Railways by clubbing few stations in each work, based on their geographical location.

Railways may send the list of such works urgently for inclusion in the List of Approved Works (LAW under ₹2.5 cr) 2016-17.

Railways may also immediately initiate action to execute the works as target date for completion of the work is December 2016. The same was decided during the review meeting conducted by Principal Secretary to Prime Minister and attended by CRB in PMO on 31st March, 2016.

This issues in consultation with the Finance (Budget) Directorate of the Ministry of Railways. Copy of Office Memorandum to Department of Economic Affairs for authorization and release of funds is attached.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Activities proposed to be undertaken by Indian Railways under Nirbhaya Fund.

The Empowered Committee of Officers have appraised and recommended Ministry of Railways proposal of "Integrated Emergency Response System of balance 1000 A1, A, B and C category stations" under Nirbhaya Fund.

2. Further, Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister has taken a review meeting of implementation of Nirbhaya Fund on 31.03.2016 wherein it was deliberated that the above work of installation of CCTV is to be executed by December, 2016.
3. The total cost of the above work to be met from Nirbhaya Fund is Rs.500 crore. Since the money will be spent as the work progresses, Ministry of Finance is requested to authorize and release an amount of Rs.200 crore immediately for the present for taking up the work, which will be accounted for in Railways' Demands for Grants by taking Supplementary Grants in the Monsoon Session of Parliament. Any further sum required for the purpose during the year will be projected to MoF in due course for further release.
4. The authorization may also specifically mention that the money being provided to Railways through Nirbhaya Fund would be 'dividend free'.
