


## **Advisory**

### **Sub: Compromise of NIC emails.**

Recently, it has been come to notice that few official email IDs on the domain XXXXX@rb.railnet.gov.in were compromised. In view of above, following measures are advised to be undertaken by the officials having emails on XXXXX@rb.railnet.gov.in domain.

- (i) Disable I-MAP service in Kavach (both in Desktop and Mobile client) by adopting the procedure enclosed as Annexure-I. On disabling of IMAP Service on email account XXXXX@rb.railnet.gov.in, user will not be able to access email through Desktop/Mobile Applications like Microsoft Outlook, GMAIL App, Yahoo mail app etc.
- (ii) Change password of emails on XXXXX@rb.railnet.gov.in from a secure computer. It is also advised that the hyperlinks received in the emails need not be clicked unless from a verified/ known email id.

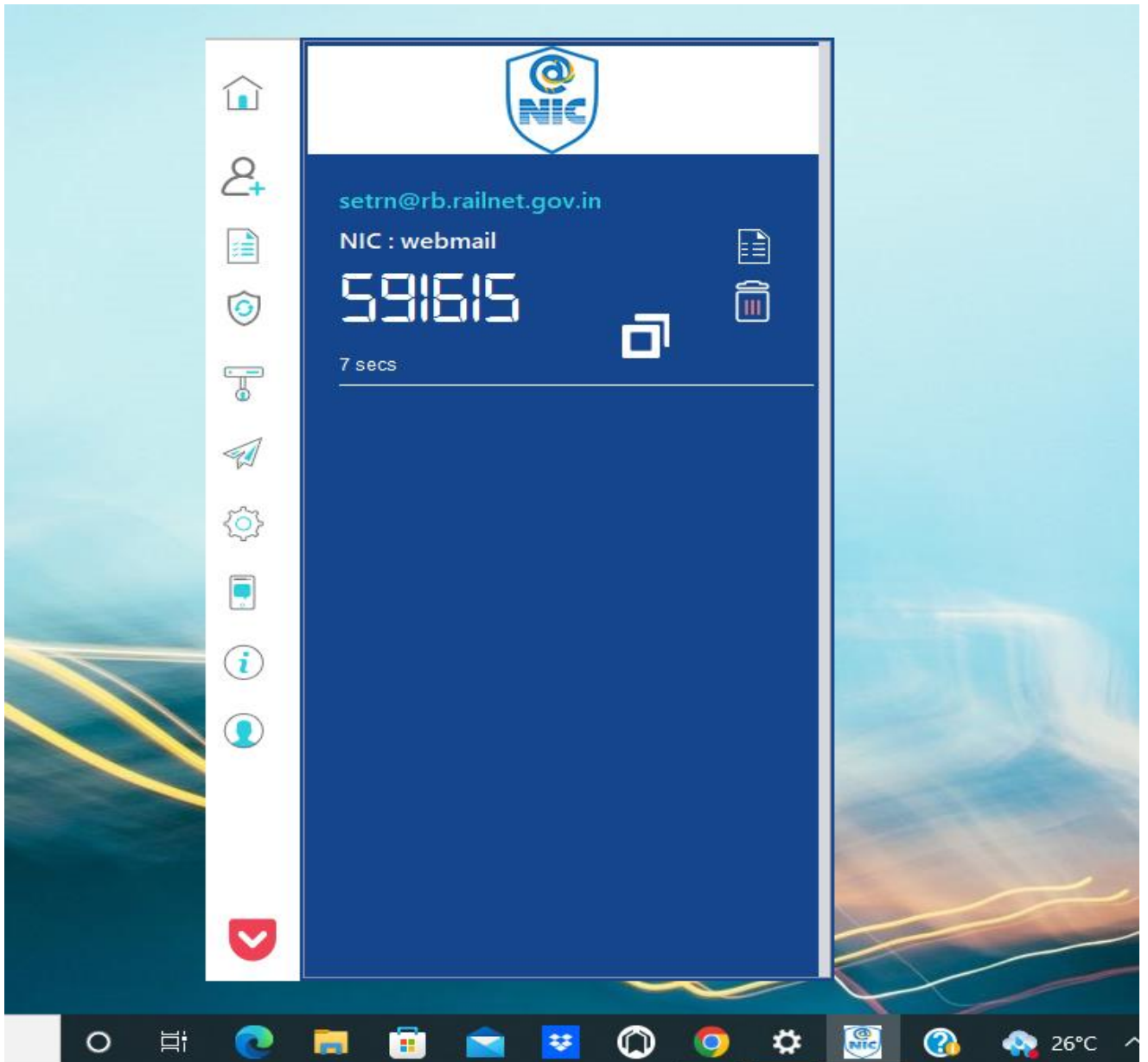

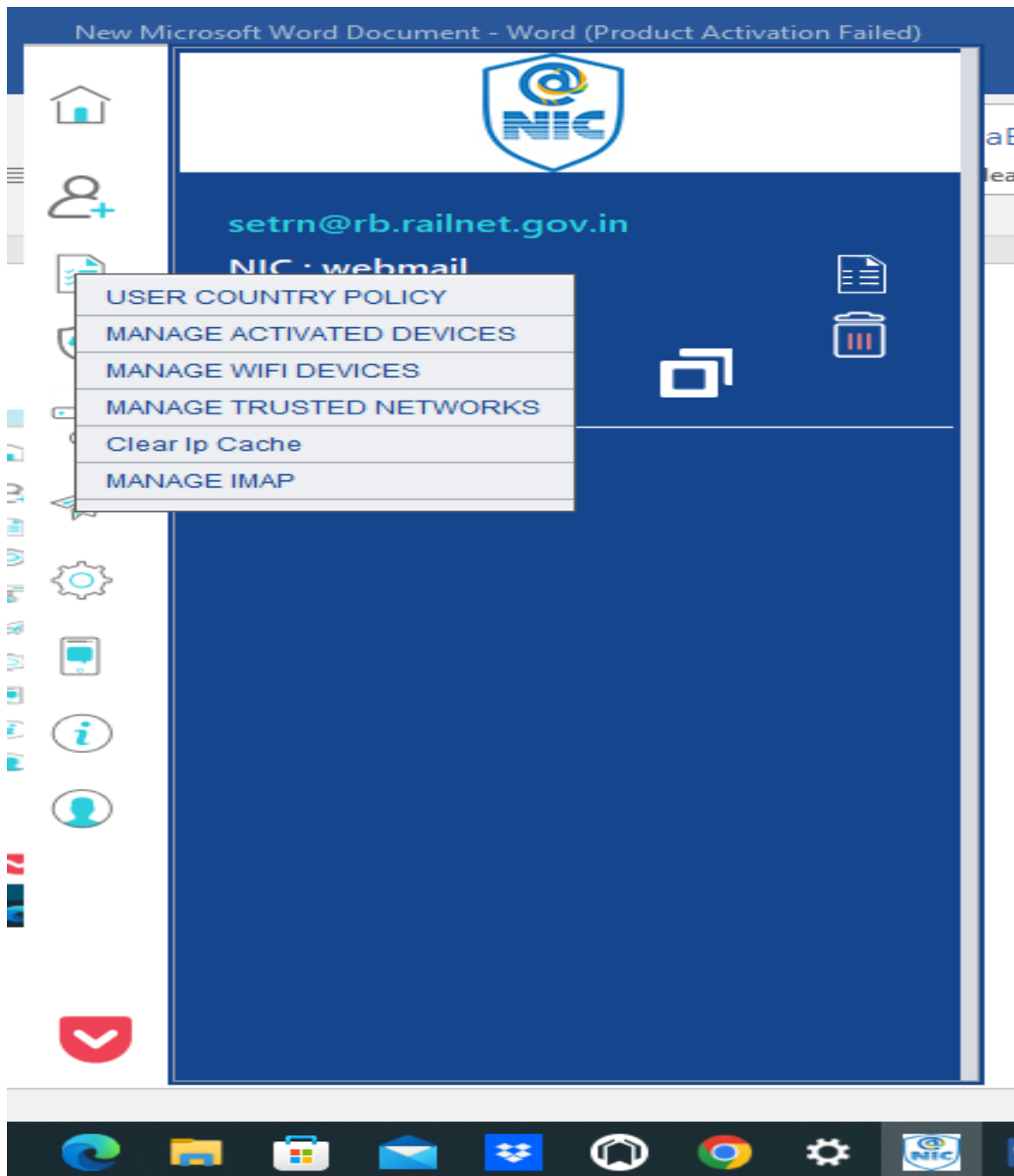
## Annexure-I

# Procedure for Disabling IMAP through NIC KAVACH Application

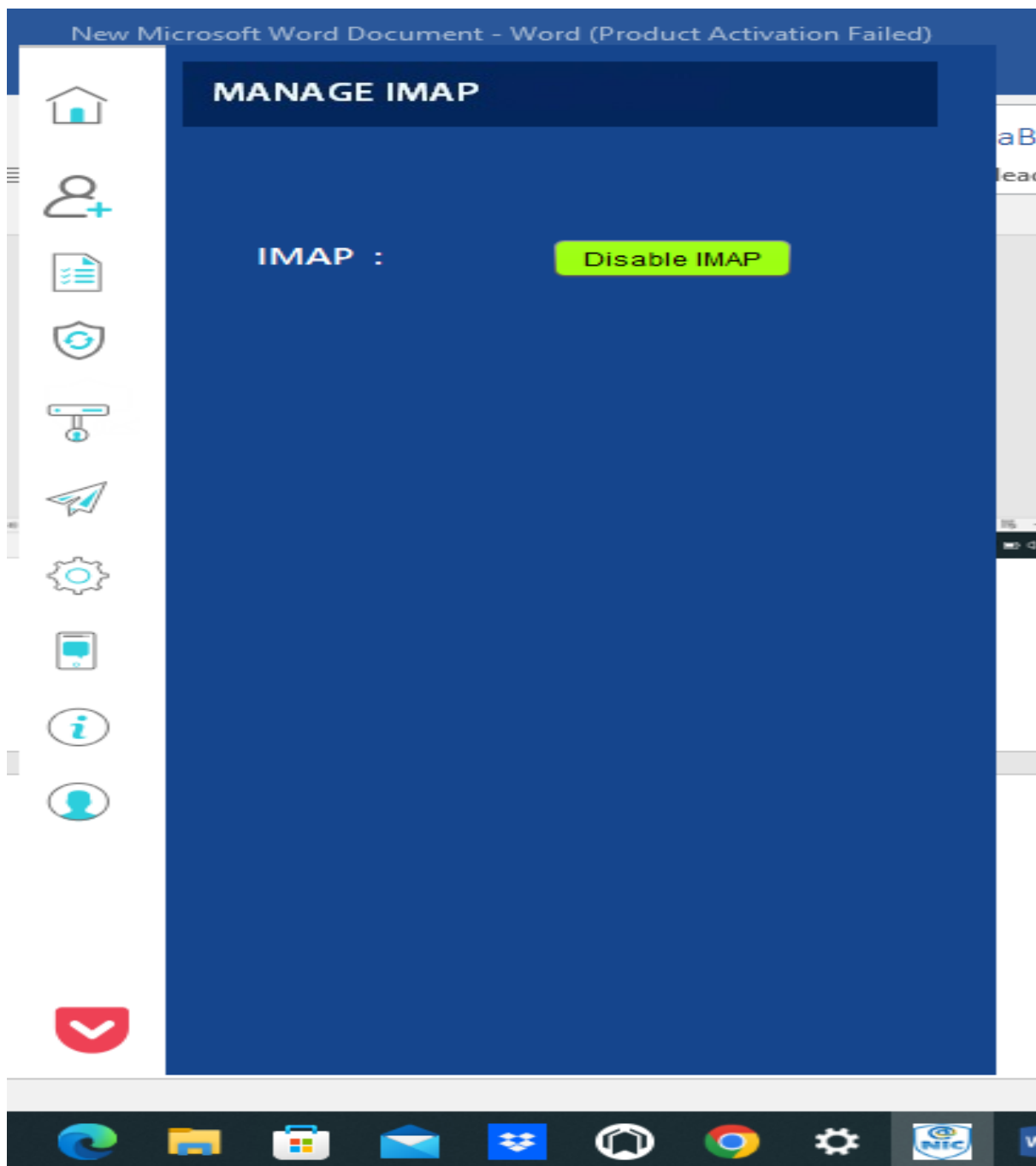
1. To disable IMAP service for (xxxxxx@rb.railnet.gov.in) E-mail ID go to NIC Kavach App.



2. Click on third icon (Manage Policy) and select MANAGE IMAP.



3. After click on **MANAGE IMAP**, an option **Disable IMAP** will be shown.



4. After clicking on Disable IMAP. Message ‘Are You sure you want to disable IMAP?’ will be shown. Click on ‘YES’. After this IMAP service will be disabled for that particular email ID.
