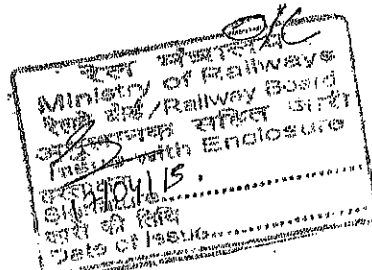

Railway Board vide its letter referred above at SN-1, had issued instructions regarding implementation of uniform numbering scheme for CUG mobile over Indian Railways. Similarly, instructions referred above at SN-2, were also issued that the CUG numbers are post specific and it must be ensured that wherever an officer is transferred from one post to another, he must hand over the CUG number to next-incumbent/Issuing Authority without fail.

It has been observed that officers are retaining CUG numbers after transfer/retirement on one pretext or other.

It is once again reiterated that CUG numbers are the property of Indian Railway (as per the agreement with service provider) and CUG number are not to be transferred to any individual. Any such CUG number which has been transferred to any individual user, must immediately be returned back.

Compliance to this effect to be given to this office by 15.05.2015 positively.
