

Sub: Payment of Revenue Share and Maintenance Charges by RailTel .

The Revised Agreement with RailTel has been signed on 21.09.2006 and sent to Railways vide Board's letter No. 2005/Tele/RCIL/1 dated 2.11.2006. As per Para 3.4 of the agreement, RailTel is expected to make payments of Railways dues including Revenue Share and Maintenance Charges, if any, at the end of every year. The Revenue Share is to be paid in terms of Clause 3.2.1 of the Agreement on the total Revenue earned by RailTel (except Revenue from Railways) every year. It has now been decided that Payment of Revenue Share by RailTel would be centralised at Board level and would be on the annual basis and apportionment of earnings to Railways would be advised by Railway Board thereafter.

Annual payment of Maintenance Charges by RailTel for OFC maintained by Railways on their behalf as well as maintenance charges payable by Railways as per Para 3.1.9 of the revised Agreement would be at the level of Zonal Railways as per details available with them.

This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
