The matter of provision of cellular phones with roaming facility by Railway Administration to all the Technical Officers of the Commission viz., CCRS, CRSs and Dy. CRSs has been considered in consultation with Ministry of Finance. The following has been decided: -


- i) Chief Commissioner of Railway Safety (CCRS) , being Special Secretary level officer is eligible for mobile phone as per terms and conditions detailed in MOF's OM No. 5(3)/E.Coord.2002 dt. 1.1.2003. (Copy enclosed as Annexure- I).
- ii) Commissioners of Railway Safety (CRSs) are eligible for mobile phones under WLL phone schemes of MTNL/BSNL as per terms and conditions detailed in MOF's OM No.7 (3)-E (Coord) /2003 dt. 14.1.2004. (Copy enclosed as Annexure II)
- iii) Dy. Commissioners of Railway Safety (Dy. CRS's) may also be provided with mobile phones under WLL phone schemes of MTNL/BSNL as per terms and conditions detailed in MOF's OM No. 7(3)-E(Coord)/2003 dt. 14.1.2004.

2. As indicated in MOF's OMs referred to in para (1) above, the monthly expenditure may be limited to Rs. 1500/- (Rs. One thousand and five hundred only) (incl. of rental and call charges) for the mobile phone of CCRS and to Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five hundred only) per month for WLL phones provided to CRSs and Dy. CRSs.


