Ministry of Railways vide above referred letter had approved provision of BSNL Cell-One phone in lieu of Railway phone for SAG/SG/JAG officers staying outside Railway colony and where Railway phone could only be provided on BSNL's leased lines

2. In partial modification to the above order, Ministry of Railways have now decided that BSNL Cell-One phone should be provided to only those SAG officers who are not staying in Railway colonies.
3. All other terms and conditions will remain the same.
4. BSNL Cell-One phones provided to SG/JAG level officers as per above referred directives should be withdrawn immediately.
5. Necessary action may be taken accordingly under advice to this office.


