Sub: Installation of SSL Certificate in all Government Websites

Ref: MeitY letter no. AA-11027/1/2020-CL&ES dated 26.08.2020 (copy attached)

An advisory has been received from MEITY (Attached order No. AA-11027/1/2020-CL&ES dated 26.08.2020) for the installation of the SSL (Secure Socket Layer)/TLS (Transport Layer Security) certificates on all the Government websites to enhance the privacy and security of the websites as well as the trust of citizens on Government websites, such that each site is available over HTTPS.

Application Security Group of NIC (Attached Release dated 23rd Sep 2020) has recommended to host a site over https by installing SSL/TLS certificates of the latest updated version. SSL certificates are mandatory for establishing trust with the website in popular browsers. They also provide security to the data transferred between the website and the website visitor by encrypting the communication. Browsers trust the websites based on SSL certificate and have started flagging sites without SSL/TLS as insecure or unsafe.

In view of the above, all concern may kindly take necessary steps for all the websites of Zonal Railways, Production Units, RDSO Lucknow, Railway Recruitment Boards, Central Training Institutions, PSUs, attached bodies, autonomous bodies etc to comply with the latest updated SSL certificates.
