Sub: Policy guidelines for composite quad cable.
Ref: WR's letter No. SG.245/1/Vol.1 dated 11.3.11.(sn.28).

The proposal of issuing of policy guidelines for maintenance of composite quad cable was under consideration in this office for sometime past. Taking into accounting provision of Revised Agreement between MoR and RCIL, Board(ML) has decided as under:-

- (i) Maintenance of composite cable may be entrusted to Western Railway.
- (ii) The expenditure incurred on maintenance of cable will be shared in a proportion of use of cable and in this case it works out 7:3 by railway and RailTel respectively.

The sharing of maintenance charges has been worked out on the basis that 6 quads in the cable will be wholly used by Railway, and of the 8 fibre, 6 fibres will be used by RCIL and 2 fibre by Railway.

Accordingly, Western Railway/RailTel are advised to enter an MoU for maintenance of composite cable and sharing of maintenance charges.

This issues with concurrence of the Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
