Subject: Surrendering of Six (06) VHF Frequencies Spot Assigned for PLC.

2. Rly. Bd. letter no.2020/Tele/WL/2/Misc dated 07.01.2022


Vide Railway Board letter dated 22.05.2007, use of 20 VHF frequencies assigned to Indian Railway for various operation and maintenance purpose including Driver and Guard communication was issued. Out of these 20 VHF frequencies, 9 VHF frequencies were prescribed for Paper Line Clear(PLC) use.

Zonal Railways vide letter dated 07.01.2022 were advised to submit the usage of above 20 frequencies along with the number of VHF sets programmed on individual frequency spots.

Based on the data received from Zonal Railways, it was observed that very few VHF sets were programmed on 6 VHF frequency spots meant for PLC. Accordingly, in concurrence with Safety and Traffic (TT/M) directorates, it has been decided that the following 6 PLC frequencies may be surrendered.

Frequency in MHz	USE
146.200	F4- for PLC; 1st section
148.050	F5- for PLC; 2nd sec
149.800	F6- for PLC; 3rd sec
149.850	F7- for PLC; 1st section
151.400	F8- for PLC; 2nd sec
151.450	F9- for PLC; 3rd sec

VHF sets programmed on above frequencies may be reprogrammed to remaining 3 VHF frequency spots meant for PLC, if required.
